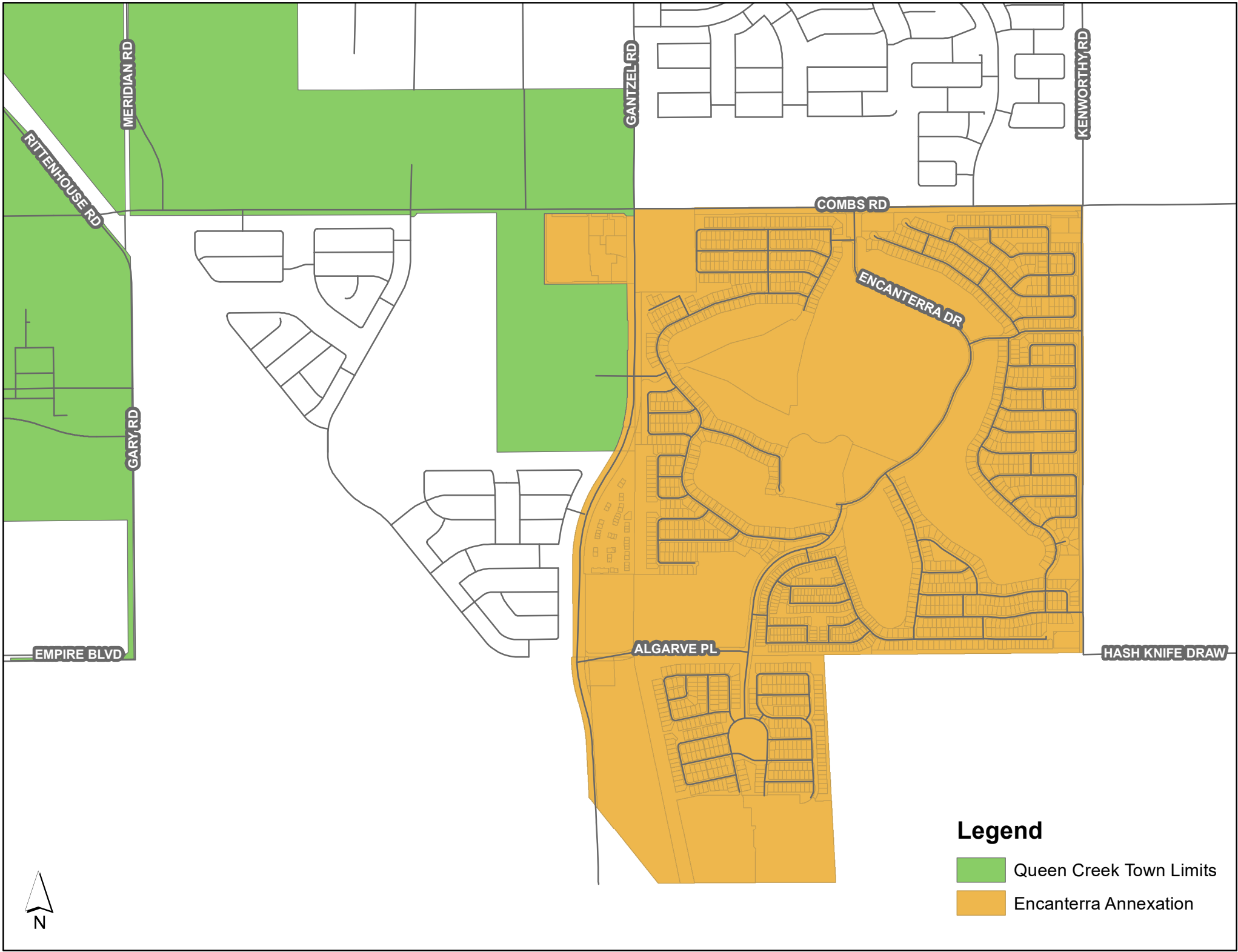


Project Narrative

In 2017, Incorporation efforts for the San Tan Valley area efforts began to increase. At the same time, residents of Encanterra and Shea Homes were interested in finding out if annexation into the Town of Queen Creek was a viable option. Since that time, Shea Homes and Encanterra residents have met with members of the Town to understand questions regarding Town services that include law enforcement, Fire and Medical services, maintaining the high quality water supply, trash and recycling services, recreation programs and more.

The map includes Encanterra and neighboring property with the intent of growing and expanding the Town of which includes a total of approximately 870 acres. Today, these areas currently reside outside of the Town's general plan however, residents of this area feel geographically connected to Queen Creek.

Recently, Shea Homes conducted a survey that was emailed to all registered Encanterra residents in order to gauge the level of interest for annexation. Almost 800 people replied and by a profound 4 to 1 margin, those who responded overwhelmingly favored annexation into Queen Creek. Based on the level of interest in annexation that the survey generated, the next step is the filing of this Annexation Application to start the annexation process.
